## Room 25 Term 2 News

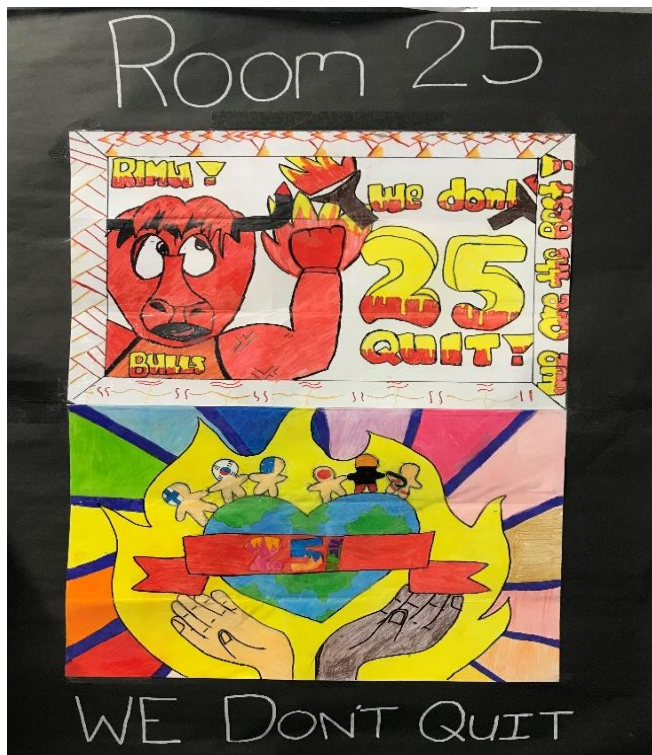
“To move a mountain, start with small stones”
