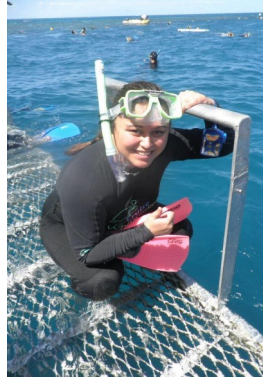
## Expectations 101
