Healthy Eating: Students are strongly encouraged to bring in healthy food. We also have a healthy eating competition that happens daily.


Lates: Students are required to be in school by 8:40 am. Anytime after this is deemed as late.

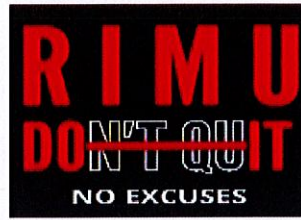
Attendance: Please make sure your child attends school as this is the main barrier to student success. As a class, we are currently hitting the 90% mark. We should be in the region of 95-100%.
