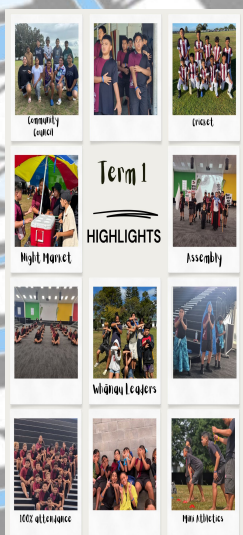

we did.

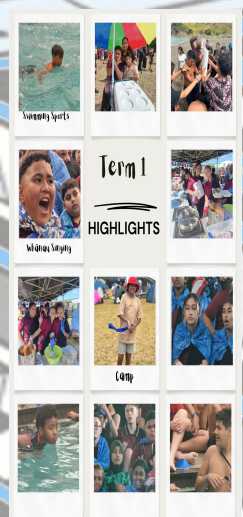
