I'm looking forward to seeing you again in Week 4 at our Student-Involved Conferences, where we'll discuss your child's progress and goals for the rest of the year.

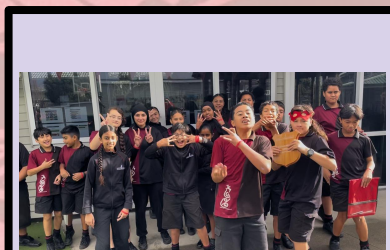

REMINDERS

ATTENDANCE:

I expect 100% attendance! Your child must be at school everyday. If your child is not able to come to school, make sure to contact me in the morning, preferably before 8:30am. I will be contacting you if your child is away without a valid reason as they can not progress with their learning if they miss school. We want and need your child at school everyday!

LATES:
