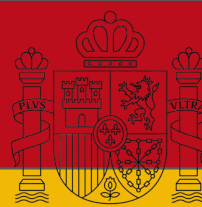


ROOM 69 TERM THREE CLASS NEWSLETTER

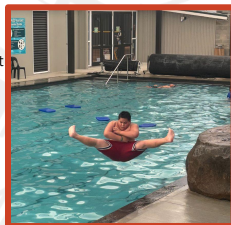

ATTENDANCE

I expect 100% attendance! Your child must be at school every day. If your child is not coming to school make sure to contact me in the morning preferably before 8:30 am.
