Kia ora, Talofa Lava, Malo e lelei, Kia orana and welcome back as we start the last term of the year!

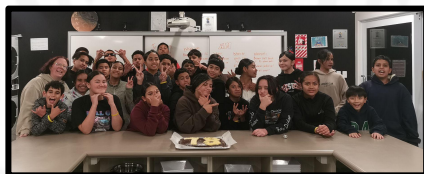
