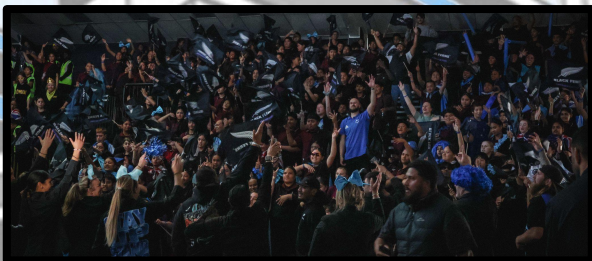
ROOM 73
