### Special Mentions

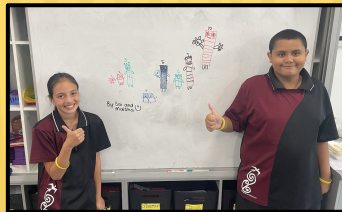

### ATTENDANCE:
