ATTENDANCE

I expect 100% attendance! Your child **must** be at school every day. If your child is not able to come to school, make sure to **contact me in the morning**, preferably before 8:30am. I will be contacting you if your child is away without a valid reason as they cannot progress with their learning if they miss school. **We want and need your child at school every day!**

LATES

School starts at 8:30am, though we encourage arrival by 8:20am. Students who are **late twice in a week**, or **three times in a term**, will be assigned Community Service. UNIFORM
