In **Friday Frenzy** all classes will be participating in **Languages**. The focus will be on Te Reo Maori through different contexts eg. School Haka/ Greetings/Tikanga. Understanding these is a vital skill in an age where New Zealand's biculturalism is highly valued in society

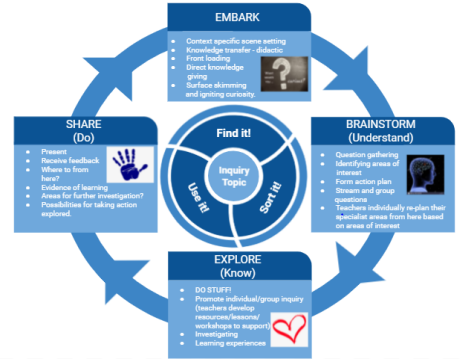
### Learning Opportunities
