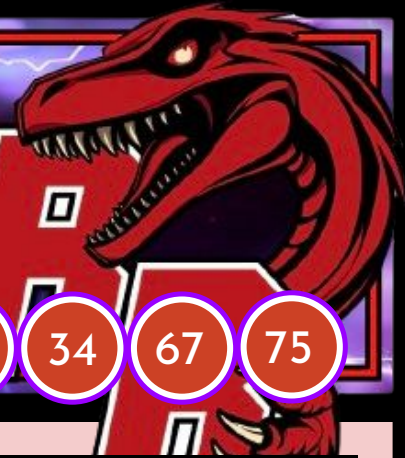


# MAKE IT HAPPEN
