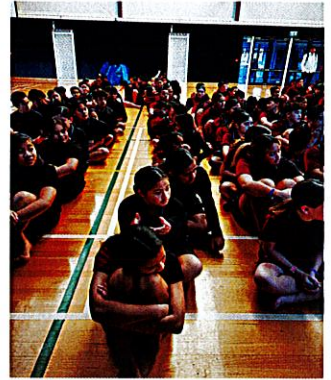

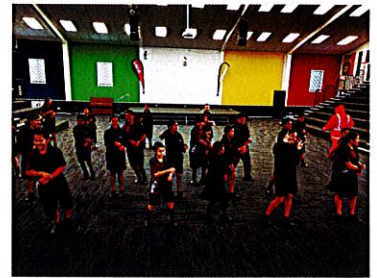
UN Show and Food Fest

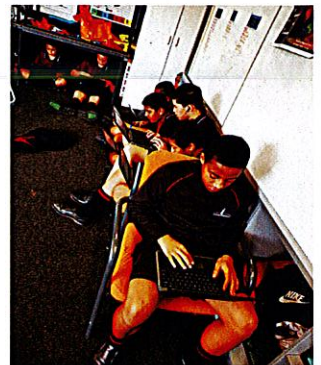


Attendance and Lateness
