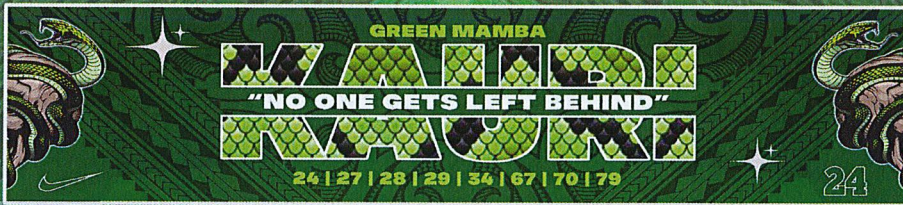

THANK YOU'S:

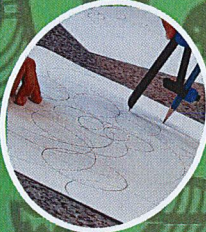
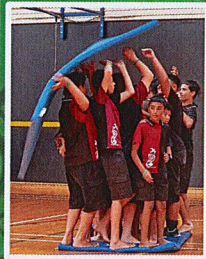

ATTENDANCE
